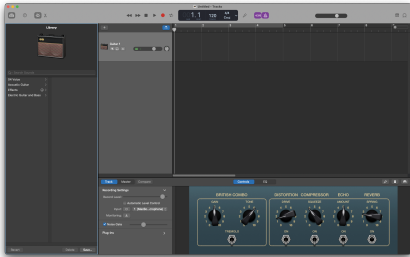


Download the latest version of auxCord.

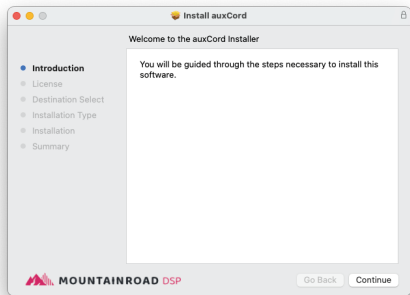
Before beginning the installation process, make sure you have downloaded the most recent version of auxCord from the Mountainroad DSP website:

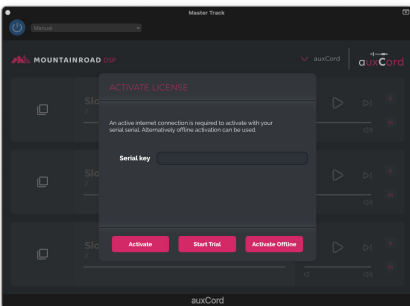
Close your daw.

Before running the installer, make sure to quit your DAW (digital audio workstation) to prevent any potential conflicts.



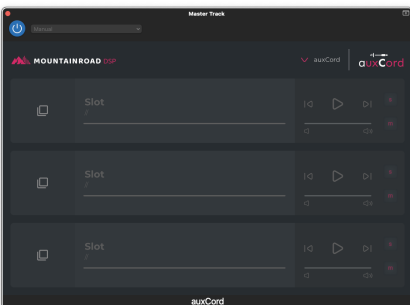
Run the installer.

Double-click on the auxCord installer to begin the installation process. Follow the prompts to complete the installation. During the installation process, the VST3, AU, and AAX formats of auxCord will be installed into the correct folders.



Launch auxCord.

After installation, launch auxCord. When you open up auxCord for the first time, you will be prompted to choose between starting the 14-day trial or entering your serial key. If you have already purchased auxCord, enter your serial key to activate the full version. If you choose to start the trial, you can enter your full serial key at any time during the 14-day trial period.



Use auxCord.

Once you have activated auxCord, you can start using it in your DAW. Make sure to load auxCord onto a Stereo track in your DAW, as it is designed to process stereo audio.

That's it! With these steps, you will be able to install and use auxCord with ease.
